

HOW TO DOWNLOAD BLUEPRINTS USING INTERNET EXPLORER

1. Click on Blueprints in the drop-down menu to find the latest Blueprint posts.

2. Click on the Blueprint collection of your choice to enter the post. Inside the post you will find:

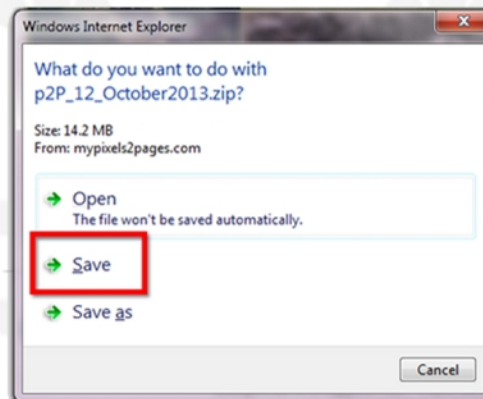
- sample pages created using that month's Blueprints
- a brief description of each sample page
- a listing content and fonts on each sample page
- buttons to download the entire month's new Blueprints with a single click – one button each for 12x12 and 11x8.5 sizes.

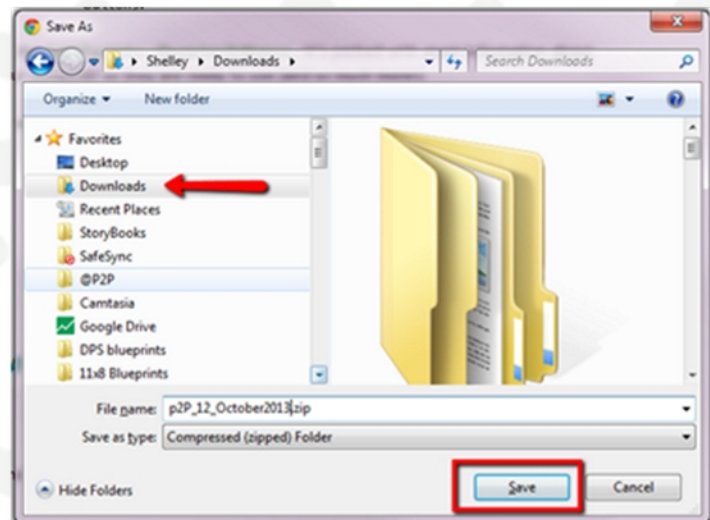

3. Click on the button of your choice (the following examples are for 12x12) and choose "Save".

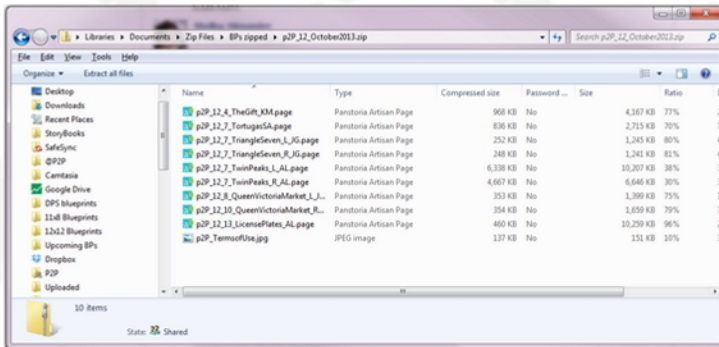


4. Your files will automatically be saved in the "Downloads" folder. If you wish to choose a different folder to save the files, choose "Save As" and identify your chosen folder. If you do that, take note of where you have saved them so that you can find them later. In this example it will save to the Downloads Folder.

5. When it has finished downloading, you will notice a bar at the bottom of your browser window. Click "Open" to open the downloaded Zip File. If you don't see that bar, open the folder that you chose to save your files in.



6. Click to open the zip folder. You will see all the Blueprint files, and the terms of use. Because the folder is zipped, you cannot use the Blueprints yet. They must be moved out of that zipped folder.

7. There are a number of ways to move the Blueprints out of the zipped file. This method is probably the easiest:

- 1 In the left panel of the Windows Explorer window, find the folder you keep your Blueprints in. Make sure that folder is visible in your window.
- 2 Select all the files inside the zipped folder, either by dragging your cursor around them all, or by clicking to select one and then typing CTRL-A.
- 3 Simply drag and drop all the files onto the destination folder.
